Quarterly Call to Prayer

Pray for:

- 1. International Mission Board (IMB)
 - PEOPLE OF CENTRAL TAIWAN Pray for more central Taiwan churches to have one-day evangelism training. One effective evangelism tool is brief but covers the full story of Jesus and enables new believers to pray, using their own words. With immediate new believer follow-up, they can quickly and simply share this good news with their friends and family. Pray for open hearts and excitement to share the gospel through this training. Ask God to open more doors to train central Taiwan Baptist churches. Ask God to provide more trainees who can help translate and make videos in multiple languages, which can be used throughout Asia.
 - Pray for our missionaries, Rachel and Anna, in Southeast Asia. The two @IMB_SBC medical missionaries, alongside their team of national believers, have built relationships with the government, allowing them to enter schools, teach basic hygiene, and meet hygiene needs.
