Protect Your Personal Information Online

A major security breach has recently been reported. Hackers associated with a notorious cybercriminal group have reportedly stolen a vast amount of sensitive personal information from National Public Data, a major data broker. This breach has the potential to impact millions of Americans, as it involves the theft of Social Security numbers and other critical personal information.

Monitor Your Accounts

Regularly review your bank statements, credit reports and other financial accounts for any unusual activity. Report any suspicious transactions immediately. You can check your credit report regularly at AnnualCreditReport.com or by calling **877-322-8228** for a free report. If available, consider enrolling in a credit monitoring service, which can alert you to changes in your credit report.

Place a Credit Freeze

Consider freezing your credit reports with the major credit bureaus (Experian®, Equifax®, and TransUnion®). This can prevent new accounts from being opened in your name without your permission.

Update Your Passwords

Ensure all your passwords are strong and unique. Use a password manager to keep track of them securely.

4

Enable Two-Factor Authentication (2FA):

For accounts that offer it, enable 2FA to add an extra layer of security. This requires two methods to verify your identity before gaining access to your account.

5

Be Cautious of Phishing Scams:

Be vigilant about unsolicited emails, texts or calls asking for personal information. Always verify the source before responding.
