On January 12, 2003, after a long day of work, Sam fell asleep in his chair and woke up in glory. "I loved him so much, and we served for so long in so many places," Evelyn said. "He served to the end just like we wanted."

Now a pastor's widow, Evelyn struggled to make ends meet. After being approved for assistance from Mission:Dignity, she felt like she could continue to do ministry in a different way. Over the last two decades, she has taught many children at her church in Red Oak, Texas. "Seeing them come to faith in Christ has been such a blessing," she said. "God has supplied me a home and met all my needs, especially through Mission:Dignity. Without you, I could not meet all my bills. I am so grateful for your ministry."
